Camp Mah-Keenac is nestled in the Berkshire Mountains in Lenox, Massachusetts, conveniently located only **2 hours away from NY and Boston**. Situated on the Stockbridge Bowl, also known as Lake Mahkeenac, the spectacular lakefront is the centerpiece of camp.

## ELECTIVE BASED AND BLENDED PROGRAM

### ELECTIVE BASED PROGRAM:

During the days at Mah-Kee-Nac, campers enjoy our Elective-Based Program. The program is built around age-appropriate options and provides each camper with a unique opportunity to explore his own interests throughout the summer while also being encouraged to try new activities.

With the support of our Program Staff, campers select their schedules each week. Days consist of 3 elective periods, 1 recreational swim or athletic league, and 1 daily choice.

Campers have the opportunity to change their schedule for the following week, which allows them to select new activities and continue with the ones they are passionate about.

Our Elective-Based Program promotes pursuing one's interests while stepping outside of their comfort zone to experience new and exciting opportunities.

### JUNIOR CAMP BLENDED PROGRAM:

Our Junior Campers, going into 5th grade and younger, follow a blended schedule combining elective-based periods and camp-selected activities by age group.

Junior Campers will have access to all the activities during the day, the blended schedule allows camp to emphasize activity exposure and create a balance of individual and group activities for our younger campers while also strengthening friendships within their own age group.
